Asbestos Management Plans on File

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA, AHERA) requires Asbestos Management Plans to be on file in each building containing asbestos, as well as in the District Office. The Union Endicott District has performed the required six month periodic inspection and surveillance in the fall of 2015 and the triennial re-inspection in the spring of 2016.

During the summer of 2016 at Charles F. Johnson, the gymnasium floor mastic and some pipe covering from above the ceiling of the gymnasium storage rooms and office were removed. At the High School floor tile was removed for the construction of the security vestibule.

An accredited asbestos inspector/ management planner performs all inspections, plans for response and the updates to the Management Plan. The results of the inspections are reviewed and recommendations for safe removal, repair and/or management of asbestos materials are implemented.

The recent inspection and reinspection data, the response actions and post-response action activities are all on file in the Asbestos Management Plans.
