PERSONAL ELECTRONICS - STUDENT

Student Personal Electronic Device:

Students are prohibited from using or having on in an operational mode any electronic device that requires a battery during instructional time, except as expressly permitted in connection with authorized instructional use in the classroom.

Permitted times include:

- Elementary
 - Before and after school
- Middle School
 - Before and after school, lunch
- High School
 - Before and after school, lunch, and only during passing time

While students are permitted to possess such devices during the school day, they are prohibited from using them in any manner which either harasses or invades the privacy of students, employees, volunteers, or visitors. If a student violates this policy, then he/she is subject to discipline under the Student Code of Conduct. Any electronic device that is permitted on school property is encouraged to be kept in a concealed manner. The school district is not liable for any electronic devices which are lost, stolen, or damaged.
