project will consist of the following:

Senior High School: Project includes replacement of existing roofing system and additional roof drains.

Ann G. McGuinness Elementary: Project includes bus loop reconstruction, sidewalk replacement, water line replacement, and exterior light replacement.

Jennie F. Snapp Middle School: Project includes replacement of bleachers, new associated electric, and wall padding replacement at Gymnasium.

Bradley Creek Bus Garage: Project includes milling and re-topping of asphalt parking areas, new concrete pad, carpet replacement, and cabinetry replacement.

Pursuant to Education Commissioner's Regulation 155.5(d), the Union Endicott Central School District will provide a safe school environment throughout this project, including an update of the school emergency plan to reflect any temporary exits or procedures needed as a result of the construction work at the school facilities. Fire drills will be held to familiarize students and staff with any temporary exits. The construction area will be separated from occupied areas of the building, all construction workers will be required to wear photo identification badges, and noise levels will be kept to a minimum while the building is occupied. All applicable federal and State rules and regulations will be strictly adhered to throughout the length of this project.
