**Re: State Pesticide Notification Law, effective July 1, 2001**

Dear U-E Families and Staff:

All schools are required to provide annual written notification to all persons in parental relation and staff regarding the potential use of pesticides throughout the school year.

U-E also is required to maintain a list of persons in parental relation and staff who wish to receive 48 hour prior written notification of certain pesticide application at their specific school sites. These notifications will explain the pesticide product name, EPA registration number, specific date and location of application. Some pesticide applications are not subject to prior notification requirements and these are listed below:

- A school remains unoccupied for a continuous 72 hours following an application
- Anti-microbial products
- Nonvolatile rodenticides in tamper resistant bait stations in areas inaccessible to children
- Nonvolatile insecticidal baits in tamper resistant bait stations in areas accessible to children
- Silica gel and other nonvolatile ready-to-use pastes, foams, or gels in areas inaccessible to children
- Boric acid and disodium octaborate tetrahydrate
- The application of EPA designated biopesticides
- The application of EPA designated exempted materials under 40CFR152.25
- The use of aerosol products with a directed spray in containers of 18 fluid ounces or less when used to protect individuals from an imminent threat from stinging and biting insects including venomous spiders, bees, wasps and hornets

In the event that an emergency application is necessary to protect against an imminent threat to human health, a good faith effort will be made to provide written notification to those on the 48 hour prior notification list.
