## Capital Project Updates

The 2017 construction season started early this year at the Union-Endicott Central School District due to the amount of work that needs to be accomplished. Work started in April, over spring break, with removal and installation of new windows at the High School. Window installation has continued off hours, so a majority of the windows facing the stadium are now complete. Windows at the Bus Garage are also 100% complete. Site work has started at Ann G. McGuinness and Charles F. Johnson with new tennis courts nearly complete and playgrounds at the two buildings well underway. Light replacement has been occurring off hours at the High School as well as new cabling for technology infrastructure. Other miscellaneous utility work at various buildings is progressing to make summer construction as expeditious as possible.

Over the summer months there will be some major areas of reconstruction including Ann G. McGuinness & Thomas J. Watson secure entry vestibules and new main offices, High School cafeteria, and High School fitness room. Window replacement will continue at the High School as well as at Ann G. McGuinness & Thomas J. Watson.

The success of any project falls in the hands of the entire team. Our team of contractors, construction managers, architects, and district staff is working together to get the project completed with the least interruption to district operations.
