Capital Project Update

Construction activity is in full swing at many of the District's buildings as we reach the half-way point of the busy construction season. At the High School, roofing work is progressing, but has been challenging due to the recent rainy weather. The High School skylight has been removed and modifications for installation of the new skylight are nearly complete. The new skylight installation should occur very soon. The cross corridor door replacement at the High School is also progressing well.

Demolition and reconstruction work at the Ann G. McGuinness front entrance loop is

progressing. The Bus Garage asphalt topping is complete and remaining work in the building will be starting up soon. While much of the work will be complete by the end of the summer, there will be some activities that continue into the fall, but will not have an impact on school operations.

The Phase 2 portion of the project will be submitted to the State Education Department for review soon. This phase is anticipated to be bid at the end of the year, and constructed during the summer of 2019.
