Capital Project Updates

2017 Capital Improvements Project

Construction work for the 2017 Capital Improvements project continued to advance over the summer months. A large focus over the summer was the start of construction at Linnaeus W. West. A new main office and secure vestibule at the entry was constructed to improve security in the building. In addition, a new nurse's office, guidance offices, and a build room were constructed.

The project also includes a new HVAC system for the building. Some of the infrastructure for the HVAC system was installed along with new water mains for the domestic water supply. Other work included new exterior windows and doors, electric service upgrade, and sidewalk replacement. The project will continue to move forward during the school year with all work being performed on second shift. The project is scheduled to be completed in the summer of 2020.
