
Capital Project Update

This past summer was another busy construction season at many of the District's school facilities. The 2015 Capital Improvements Project was brought to completion with work occurring at the High School, TJ Watson, and Ann G. McGuinness. At the High School, the large skylight and the associated roofing in the Tree Room were replaced. The new skylight system is an opaque system that allows a lot natural light into the space and is very energy efficient. In addition, many of the High School cross corridor doors were replaced and the remaining windows in the rear of the building and the Tree Room were replaced. At both Ann G. McGuinness and TJ Watson, an additional window was installed from the main office into the corridor.

Phase 1 of the 2017 Capital Improvements Project, which was approved by voters in December 2017, was also completed. This phase included installation of an entire new roofing system at the High School. Due to the amount of rain over the summer months however, the anticipated schedule was not feasible, and work continues to occur in the gym area. The remainder of the roof work is expected to be complete by the beginning of October 2018. At Ann G. McGuinness, the front bus loop pavement and sidewalk were replaced, and the majority of the canopy was removed. Exterior lighting on the building was

also replaced with energy efficient LED lights. At Jennie F. Snapp, the bleachers in the main gymnasium were replaced and new wall padding provided. At the Bus Garage, the parking area asphalt was milled and a new topping provided, and new drivers mailboxes and carpet were installed.

Design of the Phase 2 portion of the project, which includes air conditioning in the elementary schools and infrastructure replacement at Linneaus W. West, is complete and is currently being reviewed by the State Education Department. It is anticipated that construction will begin in the first quarter of 2019 on a second shift basis and be completed by September 2020.
