Capital Project Updates

It was a busy summer for construction at all of the District's facilities. The last phase of the \$7 million referendum voted on in December 2013 was completed by reconstructing the asphalt at the High School parking lot and bus loop. Vehicular and pedestrian circulation was adjusted to improve safety at the school, and a new digital sign was installed to communicate district events. Phase 1 of the \$14.2 million capital improvements project was also completed. Items that were completed are Charles F. Johnson Elementary School gym improvements, exterior door replacement at Ann G. McGuinness and Thomas J. Watson Elementary Schools, and new asphalt parking lots at George F. Johnson and Charles F. Johnson Elementary Schools. To meet the State's newest requirements for carbon monoxide detection systems, each of the facilities was equipped with a new system to detect high levels of carbon monoxide. Finally, the District's yearly Capital Outlay project created a new secure vestibule and information office at the High School to assist with improving security at the entry.
