The project will consist of the following:

High School:

1. Heat recovery unit replacement.
2. Replacement of existing heat exchangers in the boiler with new.
3. Retrofit stadium lights to be new LED light fixtures and controls upgrade.

Ann G. McGuinness Elementary School:

1. Classroom and corridor light replacement to LED.
2. Tie existing exterior lighting into the Building Management System.

Charles F. Johnson Elementary School:

1. Roof replacement.

George F. Johnson Elementary School:

1. Removal of receptacles, data drops, associated wiring and conduit. Patching of floor penetrations.

Thomas J. Watson Elementary School:

1. Classroom and corridor lighting replacement to LED.

Pursuant to Education Commissioner's Regulation 155.5(d), the Union Endicott Central School District will provide a safe school environment throughout this project, including an update of the school emergency plan to reflect any temporary exits or procedures needed as a result of the construction work at the school facilities. Fire drills will be held to familiarize students and staff with any temporary exits. The construction area will be separated from occupied areas of the building, all construction workers will be required to wear photo identification badges, and noise levels will be kept to a minimum while the building is occupied. All applicable federal and State rules and regulations will be strictly adhered to throughout the length of this project.
